Green Horse Day Out — Continuing on from the great start at the February Training Day, we invite you to again bring your new/young/green horse (or your rusty self) out in a safe environment. Someone will be there supporting you to get on, if necessary, canter in a fenced arena or introduce scary objects like carrying a jacket.

Come for 15 minutes or spend hours on your horse progressing at your own pace. Heather will have the Sand Arena near the yards set up with simple and safe activities.

Sporting Events — given that STARCC is on in June and not many of us are practiced at mounted games type events, we will be setting up the same sporting events that will be at STARCC so you can have a go and get your head around the instructions!

We'll be setting up Mug Shuffle, Keyhole, Bonfield Bounce and Barrels.

Handy Horse Course — Val has managed to get Kat White to come along and build us a SUPER handy horse course at STARCC and this is your opportunity to have a look at what is involved and to also have a go. Those of you who have seen Kat's courses will be rubbing your hands together in glee and those of you who have not will not be disappointed!
