CODE OF CONDUCT, SAFETY and INSURANCE

BRC's Code of Conduct applies to activity days, and is available to be read on the BRC website www.mybrc.net/membership. Submission of registration is taken as acknowledgement and agreement.

Please ensure that your gear/equipment/horse/pony is in

good safe working order. If you are riding, you will be required to wear an approved riding helmet (ASNZS 3838) or other approved by the EA (Equestrian Australia) and appropriate clothing and footwear as set out in the Club's Code of Conduct. You are asked to disclose any medical conditions or allergies in order for BRC to provide the best assistance in the event of an incident.

BRC is an EA affiliated club and, as such, is covered by *Public Liability Insurance*. EA members are also covered under insurance whilst riding and training their horses. However, being a BRC member only does not mean that you are automatically covered under insurance. You should consider if holding your own personal accident or loss of income insurance is right for you if you are not also an EA member.
