COMPETITOR INFORMATION

Thank you for entering the Bungendore Riding Club's "GROSVENOR PARK" Mini One Day Event for 2017. BRC would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support and wish you well for the day. Happy riding...and good luck! ☺

REGISTRATION

The registration desk will be open from 7.30am on Sunday; you will need to collect your back number(s) and XC course maps from here. Back numbers need to be worn in all three phases. We will also have copies of Medical Arm Band forms available for those who do not have their own. **For BRC non members you will be required to present your current EA card on Registration, please ensure you have your current EA member details available.**

COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITY

Please ensure that you are familiar with the current rules for low-level eventing in NSW and EA National eventing rules, which can be found at http://www.eventingnsw.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/2013_Rules_for_Low_Level_Events.pdf and http://www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/Equestrian_Australia_National_Eventing_Rules_2016_Jan_CLEAN.pdf

Submission of an entry is deemed acceptance of these rules.

Helmets must comply with EA requirements as listed on www.equestrian.org.au. Failure to wear an approved helmet shall be penalised by elimination at the discretion of the Technical Delegate.

BODY PROTECTORS ARE COMPULSORY FOR THE CROSS-COUNTRY PHASE.

DRESSAGE: start 8.30am sharp!

- This is a timed draw therefore times for dressage are **fixed**. Please be ready to ride a few minutes before your allocated time.
- Whips are not permitted without the judge's permission.
- Riders must wear gloves.
- Callers are permitted.

SHOW JUMPING

- The course will be available for walking at the times indicated in the draw. There will be strictly no additional course walks once the class has commenced.
- Draw times for the Show Jumping are approximate and provided to give an indication of riding time. The draw is in order of back numbers, please maintain an awareness of the progress of this event and be ready to ride early if required. Your co-operation in this is appreciated as it keeps the program progressing.
- Please report to the **Show Jump Marshal** when you arrive at the SJ arena ready for your round
- On completion of your round, or upon elimination, you are to immediately leave the arena at a walk via the gate.
- Under the direction of the Show Jump Marshal riders with multiple horses and committee members may be required to ride out of order, your understanding of this is appreciated.

CROSS COUNTRY – course open for walking from 7.30am

- Draw times for the Cross Country are approximate and provided to give an indication of riding time. The draw is in order of back numbers, please maintain an awareness of the progress of this event and be ready to ride early if required.
- Riders will start the course in number order; for riders with multiple rides please see the Cross Country Marshal if you unable to ride in your allocated spot.
- Nervous Nellies and Road Runners will start on course at 1 minute intervals. Scaredy Cats will start at 2 minute intervals.
- **Back protectors and medical arm bands are compulsory for the cross country phase and must be worn by all riders. Back numbers must also be worn.** If you have long hair don't forget to tie it up so that your back number is clearly visible to the jump judges.
- Please report to the **Cross Country Marshal** who will be located near the warm up jumps (see map). There is limited space at the warm-up jumps so the Marshal will limit the number of horses in the practice jump area to no more than six at a time. There is plenty of room on the main arena for warming up prior to your warm-up jumps.
- If you are eliminated on course, you will be stopped, asked to dismount and immediately leave the course at a walk and by the most direct route. If you have a fall you are eliminated and must not remount.

Please remember when you are riding your cross country that you must follow the directions of the technical delegate and jump judges. If you are travelling slowly then you should allow anyone behind you who is travelling faster to pass in a safe manner. You may be asked to move aside if you are having difficulties and if so you should do this immediately so as not to interfere with another rider. If you need to overtake please be courteous and do not attempt to do so in an unsafe or inappropriate manner. Please remember if you are an experienced rider to respect those who are less experienced. You may be asked to stop on course if there has been a serious fall. Your time will be stopped and then re-started once you are permitted to resume your course. We hope that everyone has a safe and enjoyable round.

GENERAL

- Dressage arenas will be closed for use prior to the event from Thursday 20 April.
- Please note that the dressage draw is not a “move up” draw, this means you will not be required to ride before your allocated time. The draw times for the jumping phases however ARE move up draws so you need to be prepared to ride earlier if the event is running ahead of time. These times are provided primarily to allow riders to effectively plan their day. Both jumping phases will be run in numerical order within each height class enabling riders to easily monitor the progress of the event.
- The schedule may vary on the day and is subject to change. Announcements will be made.
- Please ensure you are familiar with the rules and acceptable safety, conduct and dress, as outlined in the entry form.
- NO HUNTING ATTIRE OR PLAITING OF HORSE IS REQUIRED...light coloured jodhpurs and a collared/polo shirt is preferred.
- The briefing for XC jump judges will take place at 10:30 in the canteen. All judges must be present.
- Rivendell photography www.rivendellphotography.com will be taking photos of the event
- A sausage sizzle will be available at lunch, also a coffee van will be attending
- UNMOUNTED Presentation is scheduled for approximately 15:00 (3pm). Please stay around to make this a celebration of everyone's achievements! The Volunteers Raffle will be drawn prior to presentation.
- Please remember to return your back number prior to leaving for the day.

Venue

- The event is to be held at the Bungendore Showground, Mathews Lane, Bungendore. Please observe all signage.
- Floats/trucks must use the 2nd entrance gate to the Showground, from Mathews Lane - please park with due consideration to others. Spectator parking (horse free) is available - entry through first gate off Mathews Lane.
- No horses are to be taken beyond the signs as marked.
- Day yards are at no extra charge and are not allocated. Please ensure your yard(s) is left clean on leaving and all manure is removed.
- Camping is available – report to the caretaker on arrival and see <http://www.bungendoreshowground.com.au/> for fees and information
- Dogs must be on leashes at all times and are not permitted in the main riding arena.

Identification

- **Competitor back numbers will be supplied upon registration on the day.** These numbers must be worn during all phases of the competition and returned prior to leaving or you will be charged for their replacement.
- **If you have your own back number holder, as currently used in eventing, feel free to use this but you will be required to provide your own number insert.**
- Your emergency contact name and number will be linked to your number and will be used in case of emergency. On the cross-country course, you will be required to wear a medical armband/plastic sleeve with your details (forms and plastic sleeves will be available on the day, at registration if you don't already have one).
- **If you have your own medical armband, as currently used in eventing, this may be used.**

Safety, Conduct & Dress

- Riders are responsible for the safety of their mount and associated gear, and are bound by the rules of the competition. Please note that rules by which this competition is being run clearly state what can and cannot be allowed during each phase of the competition and it is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have read and understood the rules prior to riding at the event.
- Riders are asked to disclose any medical conditions or allergies in order for BRC to provide the best assistance in the event of an incident. This information is not, and never will be, made available to the general public or anyone other than the Organising Committee, except in the case of an incident where intervention, medical or otherwise, is appropriate.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse entry and/or continuation of the competition to any entrant deemed "unsafe or disruptive".
- Riders and handlers must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs prohibited by law during the competition. Failure to comply shall be penalised by elimination at the discretion of the Technical Delegate.

Protests

- Protests must be lodged in writing with an accompanying fee of \$50 within 20 minutes of the results being posted. An announcement will accompany the posting of all results for each class but the Organising Committee is not responsible for any person not hearing or acting on the announcement.
- Protests will be considered by an appointed Ground Jury of three and results will be provided.
- The protest fee will only be refunded if the protest is deemed valid.
